



Safeguarding Children /Child Protection Policy

The following guidelines have been compiled using documents from the Football Association for those who are in contact with children and young adults.

They are designed to protect children from all forms of abuse and protect adults from placing themselves in a position where they may be at risk of false allegations of abuse.

CRB[Criminal Records Bureau]

* All people over the age of 16 working with children will be required to undergo the CRB check at enhanced level. No person will be allowed to supervise children until this has been completed.

* It is required that the CRB check is completed every three years.

* Any CRB check that shows an offence against children or young people will deem that person unsuitable to supervise children or young people. The executive committee will discuss all other major offences before a decision is made as to whether that person is suitable to work within the club.

* Currently CRB checks are not transferable therefore all persons are required to have the CRB check through the Football Association.
